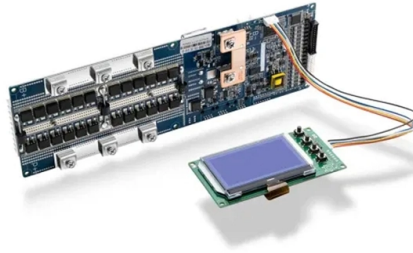


Electronic meter in distribution box

Components and Assembly A typical setup includes: Electricity Meter: Single-phase or three-phase, rated for the local voltage (e.g., 120V/240V in the USA) and current ($\geq 63A$ for main supply), with CE certification for compliance. Main Circuit Breaker: Protects the incoming line, often 2-pole 63A with residual current protection. Branch Circuit Breakers: Configured for lighting, sockets, or specialized equipment, ensuring each circuit is individually protected. Enclosure: Made of metal (grounded) or flame-retardant plastic, compliant with standards like EN 62208, and sized to allow 20% extra space for future expansion. Wiring: Incoming lines sized according to supply (e.g., 10AWG or 8AWG copper), branch wires for lighting (14AWG) and sockets (12AWG), with a ground wire at least 50% of the phase wire cross-section. Meter Box vs Distribution Box While meter boxes house the electricity meter and related service connections, distribution boxes manage and distribute power to multiple circuits. Meter boxes are typically installed at the point of entry or outdoors for easy utility access, whereas distribution boxes are installed indoors for routine operation and maintenance. In some modern assemblies, electronic meters can be integrated directly into the distribution box, providing a compact, all-in-one solution.
