

Enable SNMP on H3C Core Switch

To enable SNMP on H3C switches, you need to access the system view and configure the SNMP agent with the appropriate community strings and settings.

snmp-agent target-host trap address udp-domain 192.168.1.10 params securityname readtest
```

Save Configuration: Finally, save your configuration to ensure it persists after a reboot:

```
PlaintextCopy save
```

Ensure that the community strings and SNMP settings on your NMS match those configured on the switch for proper communication. You can verify the SNMP configuration by checking the SNMP status and community strings using the appropriate commands in the system view.
