This prevents static discharge and ensures that any accidental contact with live wires does not pose a shock hazard. Compliance with NEC 250.148 and local electrical codes is mandatory. Circuit Protection and Labeling Each circuit within the distribution box should have its own breaker or fuse, and the main switch should allow complete disconnection of power for emergencies. Proper labeling of circuits is essential for safety and efficient maintenance, especially in a location near the entrance where multiple users may access it. Maintenance Considerations Regular inspection and testing of the distribution box are important to ensure long-term reliability.
