

Establish a power distribution network automation team for management



AI Overview

A successful power distribution network automation team combines a core technical group with expanded management and operational support to optimize grid efficiency, reliability, and decision-making.

Core Team Formation Start by creating a small, highly skilled Automation Core Team (ACT) consisting of 3–5 members with expertise in both software and power distribution systems. This team is responsible for selecting initial automation use cases, running pilot projects, and establishing best practices for deployment. The ACT should have strong decision-making authority and management buy-in to ensure early initiatives are effective and aligned with organizational goals.

Expanded Automation Group Once the ACT demonstrates success, expand into a larger Automation Group by onboarding additional members with complementary skills, such as data analytics, communications, and field operations. This group handles broader automation functions, including Volt/VAR management, fault detection, recloser controls, and smart sensor integration.

A steering group with senior management and cross-department representation should oversee budget allocation, strategic decisions, and alignment with corporate objectives.

Roles and Responsibilities Key roles in a distribution network automation team include:

- Electrical Project Manager:** Oversees planning, execution, and integration of automation technologies, ensuring compliance, resource management, and timely project delivery.
- Automation Engineers:** Implement and maintain automation devices, software applications, and communication networks.
- Data Analysts/BI Specialists:** Use business intelligence and analytics platforms to monitor system performance, identify trends, and optimize operations.
- Operations Center Staff:** Coordinate real-time monitoring, control, and maintenance activities, integrat...
