OM5, in particular, supports Shortwave Wavelength Division Multiplexing (SWDM), allowing multiple wavelengths on a single fiber for 100+ Gb/s transmission, which is useful in data centers or high-capacity OBN segments. OM5 cables are easily identified by their bright lime green jackets, while OM3 and OM4 use aqua or violet jackets depending on the manufacturer. Cable Construction and Environmental Considerations OBN fiber optic cables must withstand harsh offshore conditions, including moisture, temperature fluctuations, and mechanical stress. Loose-tube designs are common for outdoor and industrial applications, providing protection against water ingress and physical strain. Tight-buffered cables are often used for indoor or controlled environments. Many cables are available with gel-filled or dry water-blocking materials to prevent moisture damage. Industrial-grade and outdoor-rated cables often feature LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) or plenum-rated jackets for safety and compliance with international standards. These cables are also resistant to electromagnetic interference, which is critical in environments with heavy electrical equipment.
