- Multimode fiber:** Used for shorter distances within a building, such as between floors or office units. It is cost-effective and supports high bandwidth over short spans.
- Connectors:** LC connectors are common for SFP modules, offering compact size and low insertion loss. SC connectors are larger but also widely used.

Switch Integration

- SFP Ports:** Modern switches often have SFP or SFP+ ports for fiber connections. Each switch port connects to another switch or core switch using fiber cables.
- Media Converters:** If a switch lacks SFP ports, a fiber media converter can convert copper Ethernet signals to fiber and vice versa, extending network reach beyond 100 meters.
