Switch-to-Server/Storage: Install a 16G FC SFP+ module in the server HBA card and the switch port. Connect using OM3 multimode fiber for distances up to 100 meters or single-mode fiber for longer distances. Star Topology: Central switch acts as the hub. Each edge switch connects via dedicated fiber links to the central switch. Ensures high bandwidth and minimal collisions, ideal for high-speed networks. Installation Notes Ensure matching fiber types (single-mode or multimode) and connector types (LC, SC, MT-RJ) on both ends. Observe wavelength compatibility between modules t...
