

Fiber Optic Patch Panel Installation Instructions

 - Swing-Out Panels:** Some panels feature swing-out trays for easier access to splices and adapters. Ensure the swing mechanism is unobstructed.
- Cable Preparation** Strip the outer sheath of the fiber cable carefully, exposing the internal fibers without damaging them. For loose tube cables, remove the gel or buffer coating as needed. Measure and cut fiber tails to the appropriate length for splicing or connector termination. Leave extra length (typically 1-2 meters) for splicing and routing inside the panel. Organize fibers using splice trays or cable management guides to prevent bending beyond the minimum bend radius.

 - Connector Termination:** Insert pre-terminated pigtailed into the adapter ports on the patch panel. Ensure correct orientation and secure connec...
