

## Fiber Optic Router Installation Package

- Optimize Router Placement:** Position the router centrally to maximize Wi-Fi coverage. For larger spaces, consider mesh Wi-Fi devices.
- Test the Connection:** Verify internet speed, device connectivity, and signal strength throughout the premises.

**Professional vs Self-Installation**

- Professional Installation:** Recommended for most users, especially if fiber needs to be run from a neighborhood terminal or requires ONT setup. Installation typically takes 2-6 hours for homes.
- Self-Installation:** Possible if your ISP provides a pre-installed ONT. Steps include connecting the ONT to the router and configuring Wi-Fi, but care must be taken with fiber connectors to avoid eye damage.
