

Fiber optic cable cannot be plugged into optical module

Clean the fiber endfaces with a lint-free wipe or isopropyl alcohol and inspect under a microscope if available. Check Port Configuration. Some devices have combo ports or require the port to be set to optical mode. Ensure the port is configured correctly and that auto-negotiation settings match the module's capabilities. Mismatched speed, duplex, or negotiation settings can prevent the port from recognizing the module. Test and Replace Components. If the module still cannot be inserted or recognized: Try a different compatible SFP/SFP+ module in the same port. Test the module in another port to rule out a faulty slot. Perform a self-loop test to verify the port functionality. Replace the fiber cable if it is bent, damaged, or incompatible. B...
