- Wall-mounted boxes:** Compact, suitable for indoor applications with limited space, providing neat termination and distribution.
- Rack-mounted boxes:** Installed in standard 19-inch racks, ideal for data centers or telecom rooms with multiple fiber connections.
- DIN-rail enclosures:** Industrial-grade, compact solutions for mounting fiber terminations alongside low-voltage devices.

Installation Considerations

- Location and Accessibility:** Choose a site that allows easy access for maintenance and cable routing, while meeting safety regulations.
- Cable Termination:** Strip jackets carefully, clean fiber ends, and terminate using appropriate connectors (SC, LC, ST).
- Splicing and Organization:** Use splice trays or patch panels to protect fibers and maintain organized routing.
- Conduit and Pathway Planning:** Ensuring proper cable management and protection.
