Tanzania and Kenya have launched a terrestrial fiber optic interconnection linking Dar es Salaam to Mombasa through the Lunga Lunga/Horohoro border, in a strategic move to improve regional Internet access and digital resilience. Dark fibre

Dark fibre can be used to create a privately operated optical fibre network that is run directly by its operator over dark fibre leased or purchased from another supplier. This is opposed to purchasing bandwidth or leased line capacity on an existing network. Dark fibre networks may be used for private networking, or as Internet access or Internet infrastructure networking. Dark fibre networks may be point-to-point, or use star, self-healing ring, or mesh topologies.

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
