Each loop should be slightly offset from the previous one to minimize mechanical pressure. After laying, flip the pattern so the loose end is on top for the next pull. This method introduces a half twist on one side of the 8 and removes it on the other, preventing permanent twists.

Use of Lubricants and Conduits: For long runs, especially in conduits, apply a compatible fiber optic lubricant to reduce friction and pulling load. Conduits, such as HDPE or PVC, protect the cable from mechanical stress, moisture, and future excavation.

Bend Radius and Vertical Limits: Always respect the minimum bend radius specified for the cable. Exceeding it can cause microbends or fractures. For vertical installations, observe maximum vertical rise limits and tie off cables if necessary to prevent fiber sliding or breakage.

Storage and Handling: Keep cable ends sealed to prevent moisture ingress, store reels on flat surfaces, and avoid sharp bends or pressure points. Do not kick or drag reels, and inspect for damage before de-reeling.

Pulling Techniques: Use proper pulling grips with swivels to prevent twisting, and consider automated pullers with tension control for long runs. Pull from the middle out to both ends for very long cables to reduce stress.
