Regional providers may offer multi-gigabit plans, such as 10 Gbps, and some experimental setups have achieved speeds of 319 Tbps over 1,800 miles. Cable quality: High-quality cores and coatings reduce light leakage and maintain speed over distance. Advanced techniques: Wavelength division multiplexing, space division multiplexing, and sophisticated modulation schemes can dramatically increase data throughput. Latency and Real-World Performance Fiber optic cables offer low latency because light signals travel directly through the fiber, unlike wireless signals that must traverse longer paths or orbit satellites. For example, a message from Seattle to Tokyo via undersea fiber cables takes about 23 milliseconds, compared to over 2...
