Maintain Bend Radius: Fiber optic cables are sensitive to bending. Always adhere to the manufacturer's recommended minimum bend radius to prevent signal attenuation or fiber breakage. Use bend radius guides or brackets at corners and tight spaces.

Use Vertical and Horizontal Managers: Vertical channels along rack sides segregate cable bundles, while horizontal organizers, such as cable bars or panels, provide structured pathways across equipment. This prevents tangling, improves airflow, and simplifies maintenance.

Separate Fiber and Power Cables: Designate separate pathways for fiber optic and power lines to minimize electromagnetic interference and maintain signal integrity.

Secure Cables Properly: Attach cables to the rack using Velcro straps or similar non-damaging fasteners at regular intervals. Avoid tight winding, pinching, or twisting.

Label and Map Cables: Clearly label incoming and outgoing cables and map their intended rack positions. This reduces confusion in high-density environments and facilitates troubleshooting or upgrades.
