- Splice Trays:** Provide organized storage for spliced fibers, protecting them from physical stress and maintaining proper bend radius. Trays can be front- or rear-accessible depending on the enclosure design.
- Fiber Enclosures:** Integrate panels, cassettes, and splice trays into a single unit, offering protection and structure for high-density fiber installations. Rack-mount or wall-mount designs maximize space efficiency while safeguarding delicate fibers.
- Fiber Cassettes:** Pre-terminated and spliced modules that simplify deployment and reconfiguration, improving scalability and reducing errors.
