- Flexibility:** Suitable for remote or hard-to-access locations, cold connectors allow technicians to terminate fibers in the field without a controlled environment.
- No Power Required:** Mechanical splicing does not require electricity, which is advantageous in areas without reliable power.
- Low Insertion Loss:** High-quality cold connectors can achieve low signal loss comparable to fusion splices for short runs, typically around 0.1–0.3 dB per connection.

Disadvantages

- Long-Term Stability:** Mechanical connections may become less stable over time compared to fusion splices, making them less suitable for permanent, long-distance installations.
- Slightly Higher Attenuation:** While low, the insertion loss is generally higher than fusion splicing, which can be critical in high-performance networks.
- Skill Required:** Proper fiber preparation is essential; rushing the process can lead to poor alignment and signal degradation.
