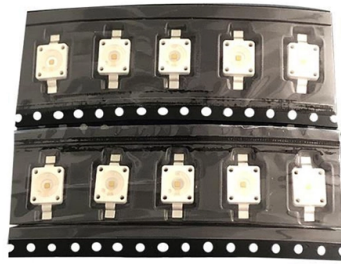


Function of Fiber Polarization Couplers
