

Function of Optical Cable Fasteners



Overview

Function: Used at the terminal or corner poles of the optical cable to bear the tension of the cable and fix its position. According to the function and structure, it can be divided into suspension clamps, tension clamps, UT clamps, connecting fittings, connecting fittings, protection fittings, equipment wire. The invention provides a fastener assembly and a method for cable retention and connector tightening of fiber optic cables. The fastener assembly includes a collar having a threaded shank extending in an axial direction from a collar platform. The threaded shank includes a passage formed. A fiber optic connector is a specialized connector that is able to connect optical fibers or an optical fiber to a networking device (transceiver or patch panel), especially with the specificity of aligning and coupling the optical fibers.
