Underslung Gantry (Lower-Beam): Operates below the deck, supported by cantilevered brackets from pier caps, ideal for longer spans (45-60 meters) or urban environments with overhead constraints. Bridge Gantry Frames: Fixed structural frames integrated into the bridge design, supporting the deck and distributing loads to piers, often used in industrial or railway bridges.
