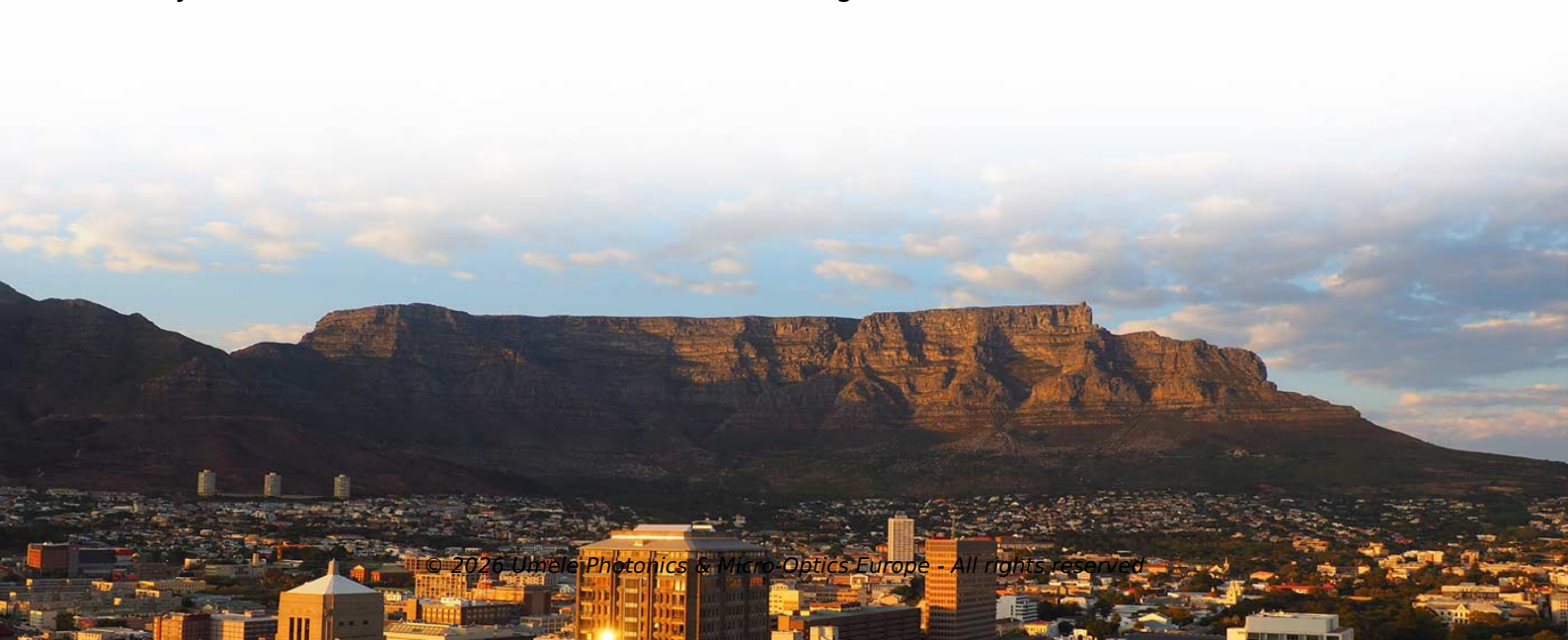


Horizontal installation spacing of distribution boxes



Overview

The distance between the distribution box and the switch box should not exceed 30 meters, and the horizontal distance between the switch box and the fixed electrical equipment it controls should not exceed 3 meters. This proximity principle reduces line losses and improves power. According to standards, the height from the bottom edge of a distribution box to the floor is generally 1. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1. The bottom surface. Horizontal Distribution Conduit System Installation
