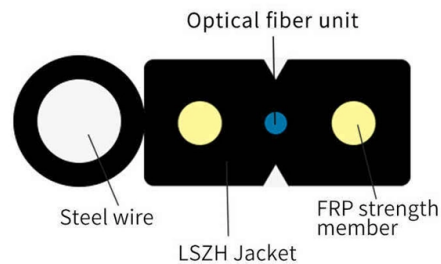

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Consequently most SM fiber is field terminated by splicing on a factory-terminated pigtail or using prepolished/splice connectors or SOC's (splice-on connectors.)
