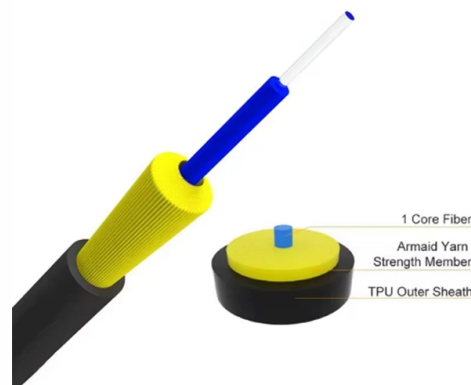


How are cable tray elbows installed

Conduit drop-outs connected to elbows should also be bonded using a compression lug or grounding bushing to ensure safety. Select the appropriate tray type (ladder, ventilated trough, or solid-bottom) based on cable type and environment. Align elbows precisely with straight sections to avoid kinks or sharp bends in cables. Use proper support spacing to prevent sagging; typical spans range from 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load.
