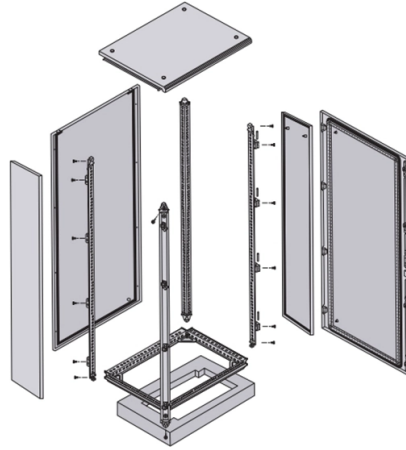


How many outputs does a 400A column head unit have
