**Outdoor and Waterproof Boxes**

For outdoor or waterproof distribution boxes, additional considerations include protection from water ingress and environmental hazards. The box should be positioned at least 300 mm above the highest recorded flood level to prevent water damage. Adjustable mounting brackets or pedestal systems can allow micro-adjustments to achieve both ergonomic access and proper drainage. Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2–4 inches to avoid moisture accumulation.

**Safety and Accessibility Considerations**

Avoid wet or hazardous areas such as bathrooms, sinks, or corrosive environments. Ensure sufficient clearance around the box for airflow, maintenance, and emergency access. Maintain level and stable installation, with vertical deviations within 3 mm for boxes...
