

How to check access devices on a switch

You can identify devices on a switch by using MAC address tables, ARP tables, LLDP/CDP protocols, or network discovery tools to map devices to specific ports. Using Switch Commands Access the switch via SSH, Telnet, or console. Find the MAC address of the device: On a Layer 3 switch, use `show arp` with the device's IP to get its MAC address. Locate the port on the switch: Use `show mac-address-table address` to see which port the device is connected to. For a specific port, use `show mac-address-table interface` to list all MAC addresses on that port. Trace through the network: If the MAC appears on an uplink port, log into the downstream access switch to find the exact port. Using Discovery Protocols LLDP (Link Layer Discovery Protocol) or CDP (Cisco Discovery Protocol) can help identify connected devices and their link information. Commands like `show lldp neighbors` or `show cdp neighbors` display device names, ports, and VLANs. Using Network Tools Network scanning tools like ManageEngine OpManager, Paessler PRTG, or Site24x7 can automatically discover devices and map them to switches and ports. For smaller networks, command-line tools like `arp -a` (Windows/Mac) or `ping` combined with `arp` can help identify active devices and their MAC addresses. Best Practices Document MAC addresses and port assignments to simplify future audits. Regularly update ARP and MAC tables to ensure accurate mapping. Use VLAN information to narrow down device locations on larger networks. By combining switch CLI commands, discovery protocols, and network monitoring tools, you can efficiently identify which devices are connected to each switch port and maintain an accurate network inventory.

Log into the access layer switch, and use the show mac-address address and copy and paste in the mac address. This will show you the port the device is connected to.
