Consider future expansion: If you plan to add devices like EV chargers or heat pumps, select breakers and panels that can accommodate additional load.

Choose the Correct Breaker Type Standard breakers: Protect against overloads and short circuits; suitable for general household circuits. GFCI breakers: Protect against ground faults; required in kitchens, bathrooms, garages, basements, and outdoor circuits. AFCI breakers: Detect dangerous electrical arcs that can cause fires; recommended for bedrooms and living areas.

Match Amperage and Voltage Ratings Amperage rating: Choose a breaker rated slightly above the maximum expected load of the circuit to avoid nuisance trips while ensuring protection. Voltage rating: Ensure compatibility with your home's system, typically 120V for single-pole and 240V for double-pole circuits.
