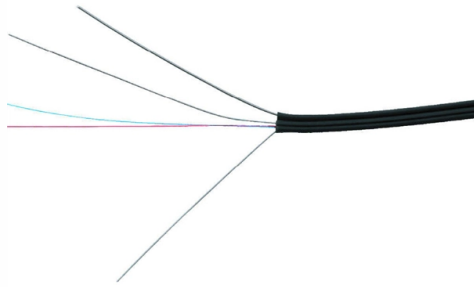


How to connect a computer fiber optic cable
