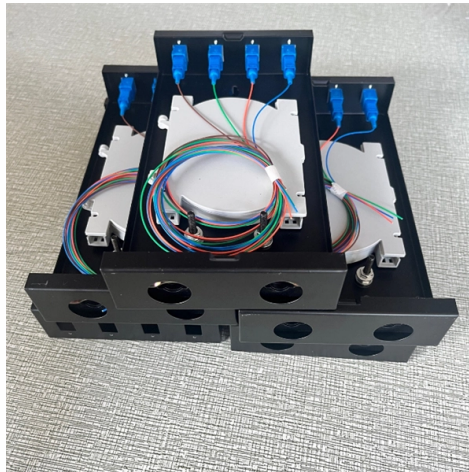


How to connect a dual-core fiber optic socket panel

Insert Connectors into Adapters Align the Tx and Rx fibers correctly: one fiber for transmitting data, the other for receiving. Push the SC or LC connectors into the corresponding adapter slots until the latch clicks, ensuring a firm connection. Manage Fiber Slack Route the fibers along the panel's dual-layer structure to avoid sharp bends. Maintain the minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss or fiber damage. Close the Protective Hood Once all fibers are connected and secured, replace the protective hood to prevent dust contamination and accidental disconnection. Test the Connection Use an optical power meter or OT...
