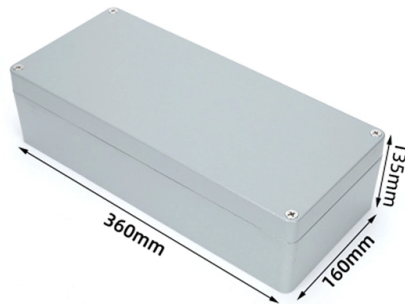


How to connect a fiber optic SC connector to a router
