

How to connect a landline phone via fiber optic cable

You can connect a landline phone to a fiber optic setup by plugging it into the VoIP port on your modem or Optical Network Terminal (ONT), with options depending on your home wiring configuration.

- 3. Using Integrated Wiring Without a Voice Box** For homes with integrated wiring but no voice box: Use an extra telephone cable similar to your phone's existing cable. Plug one end into the VoIP 1 port on the modem and the other end into any jack point in your home. This allows your landline phone to function through the existing wiring.

Additional Considerations

- Power Requirement:** Fiber landline phones require electricity, so ensure the phone is plugged into a wall socket.
- VoIP Modems:** Modern fiber modems often support Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP), allowing standard landline phones to make calls over the internet while maintaining high call quality.
- Configuration:** Some modems may require enabling phone service or adjusting Quality of Service (QoS) settings to prioritize voice traffic for better call clarity.
