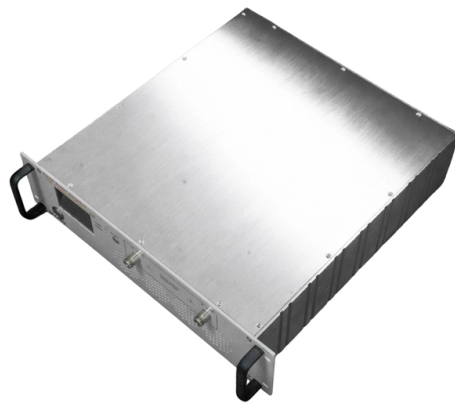


How to connect a set-top box to a router to receive fiber optic cable
