

How to connect optical fiber cables in series

- Prepare the Fiber:** Strip the outer jacket and clean the bare fiber with isopropyl alcohol to remove dust and oils.
- Cleave the Fiber:** Use a precision fiber cleaver to create a perpendicular, defect-free end face.
- Insert into Connector:** Depending on the connector type, insert the fiber into the ferrule and secure it using glue, epoxy, or a latch mechanism.
- Test the Connection:** Use an optical power meter or network tester to ensure minimal signal loss.

Using Splices

- Prepare the Fiber:** Strip, clean, and cleave the fiber ends as above.
- Align the Fibers:** For fusion splicing, place the fibers in the splicer's alignment jaws. For mechanical splicing, insert fibers into the splice holder.
- Join the Fibers:** Activate the fusion splicer to fuse the fibers or secure them mechanically.
- Protect the Joint:** Use a splice sleeve or protective enclosure.
