

How to connect power cables to a network cabinet

Typically, power cables are routed from the bottom or rear of the cabinet, while network cables follow a different path, often from the top or side.

Step 4: Secure and Label Cables Use zip ties or Velcro straps to secure power cables along the cabinet frame. Label both ends of each cable with the corresponding device and PDU port number. This simplifies maintenance and troubleshooting.

Step 5: Connect Devices Plug the power cable into the device first, then into the PDU or outlet. Ensure the connection is firm and that the cable is not under tension. Leave enough slack to allow for device removal or repositioning without disconnecting the cable.

Step 6: Safety Checks Verify that the PDU or outlet is properly grounded. Avoid overloading circuits by checking the total amperage of connected devices. Maintain clear access to the cabinet for emergency shutdowns or maintenance.
