

How to connect the 24 ports of the core switch

Initial Configuration

Access the Switch: Connect a PC to the switch using a console cable (RJ-45 to DB-9 or USB) and open a terminal emulator like HyperTerminal or PuTTY.

IP Address Setup: Use the Configuration Setup Wizard or CLI to assign an IP address to the switch for management access. This allows you to configure VLANs, QoS, and other network settings.

Change Default Credentials: Immediately update the default username and password to secure the switch.

VLAN Configuration: Assign ports to VLANs as needed to segment traffic and improve security. Each port can be configured individually or in groups.

QoS and Traffic Management: Enable Quality of Service (QoS) to prioritize critical traffic like VoIP or video streaming.

Best Practices

Label Cables and Ports: Clearly label each cable and port to simplify troubleshooting and future expansion.

Avoid Overloading Ports: Ensure that each port is connected to a single device or properly configured hub to prevent collisions.
