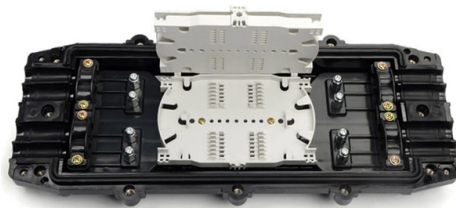


How to connect the fiber optic terminal box of Huijue Communication

Step 4: Install Fiber Adapters Insert SC or FC adapters into the designated slots in the terminal box (). Connect the pigtails to the adapters, which will allow easy connection to jumpers or customer-side devices (). Ensure adapters are properly aligned and secured to prevent signal loss.

Step 5: Cable Management and Storage Coil any excess fiber neatly inside the box to avoid tangling and maintain the standard bend radius (). Use the internal cable fixing points to secure both incoming and outgoing fibers (). Label each fiber and port clearly for future maintenance and troubleshooting ().

Step 6: Testing and Verification After all connections are made, use a fiber optic power met...
