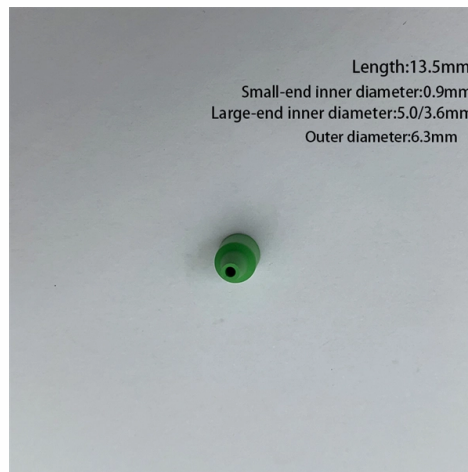


How to connect the power supply to the fiber distribution box
