

How to connect the three ports of a fiber optic switch

Step 4: Configure the Switch Log in to the switch using a terminal client or web interface. Enable the fiber ports and configure the speed and duplex settings if required. Assign VLANs if you want to separate traffic for each port or device. Save the configuration to ensure settings persist after a reboot.

Step 5: Test the Connections After connecting, verify link status on each port. Most switches provide LED indicators or software commands to confirm that the fiber link is active and transmitting data correctly.
