Three-phase boards: Each way can accommodate multiple single-phase circuits depending on configuration. For example, a 4-way three-phase board may support 12 single-phase circuits. Practical Considerations Future-proofing: It is recommended to include extra ways (around 20% more) to allow for future expansion, such as adding solar panels, EV chargers, or additional equipment. Compliance and safety: The total number of circuits must comply with local electrical codes and the board's rated current capacity. Overcrowding a board can lead to overheating and safety hazards. Board selection: Choose a board based on the total number of circuits required, phase type, and load distribution. Larger boards often include advanced busbar systems and m...
