

How to fix suspended cable trays in a factory

- Ceiling-Mounted Brackets:** Adjustable brackets (e.g., TFP-A) can attach to ceiling profiles or corrugated sheets and provide stable mounting points for rods or rails.
- Tray Hangers and Mounting Clamps:** Use these accessories to provide additional support for heavy cables and prevent sagging.

Organize and Protect Cables

- Cable Organizers and Dividers:** Keep cables separated and prevent tangling, which reduces stress on the tray.
- Cable Tie Mounts:** Secure cables within the tray to prevent slipping or shifting.
- Tray Covers:** Protect cables from environmental hazards and maintain safety compliance.
