

How to install an overhead optical distribution box

Rack combination (if applicable): When multiple boxes or frames are installed side-by-side, connect adjacent units with bolts for structural integrity.

Main cable handling: Select appropriate cable seals based on the cable diameter (9–16 mm for main cables) and pass the cable through hose clamps.
Sheath removal: Strip the outer layers carefully, leaving the loose buffer tube and strength members intact. Clean any oil or filler material.
Fixing fibers: Secure the main fibers with metal plates and insert them into fiber melting protection tubes to prevent damage.
- Fiber Routing and Splicing**
Protective connectors: Use protection connectors for ribbon or bundle fibers before routing into the ODB.
Routing to panels: Route fibers to the splicing panel (first level) and distribution/terminal panel (secon...
