Position the cable tray: Maintain proper spacing and alignment according to the cable tray manual, ensuring minimum bend radius and secure support. Apply sealing materials: Insert firestop packs or weatherproof pads around the tray and cables. Apply mastic or sealant to all edges to ensure a tight, void-free seal. Cover and finish: Use square, consistent cover plates for firestops or frame closures for weatherstops. Paint or finish as required for aesthetics and protection.
