

How to install power strips in a network server rack

Step 5: Configure Network-Enabled PDUs Connect the PDU to a TCP/IP network using a Cat5e/6 cable. Retrieve the DHCP-assigned IP address from the device's MAC address. Access the PDU via a web browser or terminal program (e.g., HyperTerminal or PuTTY) to configure monitoring, alerts, and remote control (). Verify that all circuit breakers or fuses are properly set and seated ().

Step 6: Power On and Test Connect the PDU to the main power source and switch it on. Confirm that all connected devices receive power and that the PDU's monitoring features are functioning correctly ().
