- Do not open the box while power is on; this is critical in hazardous areas.
- Use certified components and cables rated for explosion-proof applications (EX or ATEX markings) to prevent sparks or arcs.
- Regular inspections are recommended at least annually, or more frequently in high-risk environments, to ensure seals, wiring, and the enclosure remain intact.
- Outdoor installations should include rain covers and be positioned away from heat sources, collisions, or corrosive...
