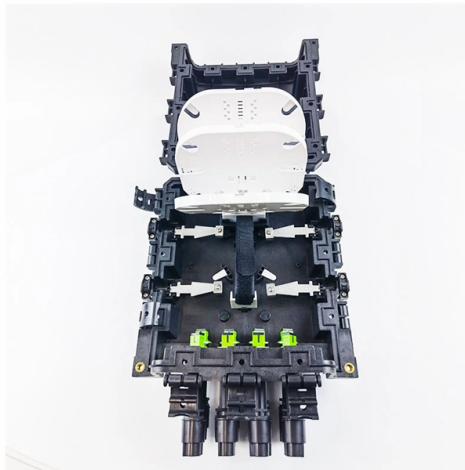


How to open the fiber optic cable stranded wire

- 4. Separate and Trim Kevlar Strands**
Carefully separate the Kevlar or aramid strands from the fiber bundle. Use Kevlar scissors to trim any excess strands without cutting the fiber itself.
- 5. Strip the Fiber Coating**
Use a fiber optic stripper to remove the protective coating from each fiber, exposing the bare glass. Avoid scratching or nicking the fiber core, as this can affect signal quality.
- 6. Cleave the Fiber Ends**
Use a precision fiber cleaver to cut the fiber ends at a clean, perpendicular angle. This ensures a low-loss connection for splicing or connector installation.
- 7. Clean the Fiber**
Wipe the exposed fiber with an alcohol wipe to remove any debris or oils. Clean fibers are essential for reliable splicing or mechanical connections.
- 8. Splice or Connect**
Insert the prepared fiber into a mechanical splice or connector assembly.
