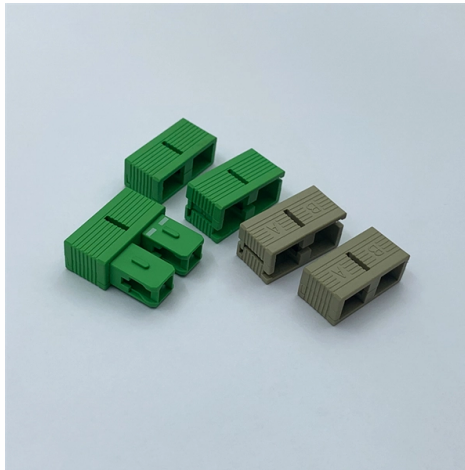


How to place the fiber optic tray and flange

Positioning the Fiber Optic Tray

Installing the Flange

Insert Square Nuts: Place square nuts into the slots at the end of the vertical supports or crossbars that will hold the tray.

Position the Flange: Align the flange with the tray or support structure. Insert T-bolts into the side channels of the tray and slide the bracket up against the tray, ensuring the wings of the T-bolt remain inside the slots.

Tighten Flange Bolts: Use the appropriate M6 flange bolts (e.g., 9mm or 14mm depending on the setup) to secure the flange. Ensure crossbars are horizontal and perpendicular to the tray before fully tightening.

Check Alignment: Verify that the tray is flush with the flange and that all fasteners are tight. Ensure the tray is straight and adequately supported along horizontal runs.

Final Steps

Install Tray Cover: Snap the clear cover onto the tray, aligning the holes with the tray base to protect fibers.

Verify Fiber Management: Check that all fibers are inside retaining tabs, maintaining proper bend radii to prevent signal loss.

Plan for Expansion: Leave room for future fiber additions and ensure the tray system is flexible for maintenance...
