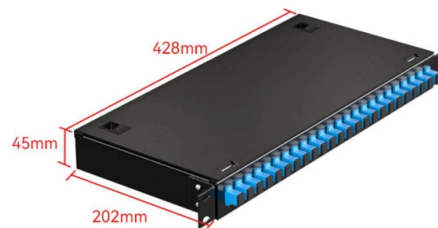


How to set up a router for a mobile fiber optic adapter

To set up a router for a mobile fiber optic adapter, connect the fiber to an ONT, link the ONT to your router via Ethernet, and configure the router with your ISP credentials and Wi-Fi settings.

Step 1: Gather Required Equipment

- Fiber optic cable:** Usually a thin yellow cable with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors.

Step 3: Link the ONT to Your Router

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a connection.

Step 4: Configure the Router

Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1). Enter your ISP-provided credentials (username, password, or PPPoE details). Update the router firmware if prompted to ensure compatibility and security. Set up Wi-Fi: choose a network name (SSID) and a strong password. Optionally, enable Quality of Service (QoS) to prioritize traffic for video calls or gaming.

Step 5: Optimize Placement and Test

Place the router centrally for best Wi-Fi coverage. Test the connection by checking internet speed and stability on multiple devices. For larger areas, consider mesh Wi-Fi systems to extend coverage.

Step 6: Troubleshooting Tips

Ensure fiber connectors are clean and properly seated to avoid signal loss. Verify Ethernet cables are CAT6 or higher for optimal sp...
