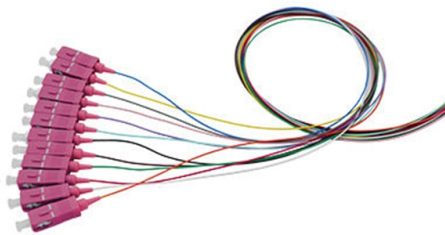


How to splice black fiber optic cables

Align the Fibers: Place each fiber in the fusion splicer's V-groove. The splicer uses cameras and motors to align the fibers precisely.

Fuse the Fibers: Activate the splicer to generate an electric arc that melts the fiber ends together, creating a continuous optical path with minimal loss (typically ~ 0.1 dB).

Protect the Splice: Slide a protective sleeve over the fused area and heat-shrink it to secure the joint against mechanical stress and environmental factors.

Mechanical Splicing (Alternative)

Mechanical splicing is faster and temporary, using an alignment device and index-matching gel to hold fibers together. It is suitable for short-term repairs or when fusion splicing equipment is unavailable, but typically has slightly higher signal loss (~ 0.3 dB).

Best Practices

- Always handle fibers carefully to avoid bending below a 30 mm radius.
- Keep tools and splicer clean to prevent contamination.
- Follow manufacturer guidelines for consumables and splice sleeves to ensure long-term reliability.
- Test the splice with an optical power meter or OTDR to verify low loss and...
