

How to wire from the distribution box to the branch circuit

Connecting the Main Supply: Connect the incoming phase and neutral to the main breaker. The main breaker output feeds the busbar or directly the RCCB input.

Branch Connections: Connect each branch circuit to its respective breaker. The live wire goes to the breaker input, the neutral to the neutral bar, and the ground to the earth bar. For duplex outlets, ensure jumper connections maintain continuity between receptacles.

Wiring Direction and Organization: Route wires neatly—left side for incoming power, right side for outgoing circuits. Use cable ties to keep wires straight and organized.

Safety Checks: After wiring, inspect for proper connections, no exposed conductors, and correct breaker...
