

How to wire the fan control cabinet

Identify Wires

- Ground Wire:** Bare copper or green, connects to the metal box and switch grounding terminal for safety.

Wiring Steps

Plan the Circuit: Determine the type of fan control (pull-chain, wall-mounted speed control, or remote receiver) and ensure compatibility with your fan.

Connect the Wires: For a wall-mounted speed control, connect the line wire to the switch input and the load wire to the fan's motor input. For a pull-chain switch, match the line wire and the fan's multiple load wires corresponding to different speed settings. For a fan with a receiver, connect the line, neutral, and ground from the NM cable to the receiver's line side, and connect the load side to the fan and light wires.

Secure Connections: Use wire nuts or terminal screws, ensuring no exposed copper is left outside the connectors.

Grounding: Attach the ground wire to the metal box and switch grounding terminal to prevent electrical shock.

Testing After wiring, restore power and test the fan control. Adjust speeds or light functions to confirm proper operation. If the fan does not respond correctly, recheck all connections and ensure the switch type matches the fan's requirements.

Additional Tips Use 14/2 or 12/2 NM cable depending on the fan's amperage draw. For whole-house fans, ensure the main panel has sufficient capacity and follow local...
